Reply to bail application not filed by State.

2. Heard on the bail application filed on behalf of applicant/accused. It has been averred in the application that on 17.11.2025 applicant/accused is suffering from fever and suffering from depression and anxiety due to this reason, he could not appear before this court on 17.11.2025 and this Court on the same day issued non-bailable warrants of applicant/accused and cancelled the bail bonds and surety bonds vide order dated 17.11.2025. That applicant/accused was also absent on the other dates due to suffering from depression and anxiety. That on 25.02.2026, this Court has declared applicant/accused proclaimed person. That applicant/accused is in judicial custody since 11.03.2026. That applicant/accused undertakes not to jump over the bail in future or not to leave India without getting prior permission of this court. That applicant/accused undertakes to appear before this Court on each and every date of hearing and further undertakes not to tamper with the prosecution witnesses. Lastly, prayer has been made that applicant/accused may kindly be released on bail.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to the State through learned APP for the State. Although, reply to bail application not filed by State however, learned APP opposed the bail application orally by stating that applicant/accused is a habitual offender and has committed heinous crime; that there are circumstances that he may abscond, therefore, he is not entitled for bail.

4. I have heard learned counsel for applicant/accused, learned APP for the State and have also gone through the case file and other documents carefully.

5. Main file has been put up the Ahlmad. Perusal of the file further reveals that vide order dated 01.04.2021 applicant/accused Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku was granted bail, however, on 17.11.2025 applicant/accused Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku had absented himself without any intimation to this Court due to which vide order dated 17.11.2025 non-bailable warrants of applicant/accused Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku were ordered to be issued to procure his presence. Thereafter, vide order dated 25.02.2026 applicant/accused Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku was declared proclaimed person.

It is pertinent to mention here that applicant/accused Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku was produced before this Court on 11.03.2026. It is further pertinent to mention here through this application applicant/accused undertaken not to jump over the bail in future and to appear before this Court on each and every date of hearing. Therefore, in

view of the reason mentioned of non-appearance of applicant/accused, this Court is of the opinion that a lenient view has been taken and applicant/accused **Gurcharan Singh @ Kaku** is ordered to be released on bail in the present case on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹70,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-

- i. That he will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing;
- ii. That he will not tamper with the prosecution evidence;
- iii. That he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

Bail application stands disposed of accordingly. Copy of this bail order be sent to the Superintendent of concerned jail through e-mail.

6. Bail bonds and surety bonds on behalf of applicant/accused furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued forthwith. These papers be attached with the remand papers/challan.
