IA no. 1/26 (plaintiff's application seeking impleadment of three daughters of Mohd. Saleem namely Mumtaz, Nargis and Neha as D-9 to D-11)

1. Copy supplied.
2. Counsel for D-1 to D-4 and D-8 accepts notice of the present application on behalf of proposed D-9 to D-11. He submits that D-9 to D-11 have no objection in case they are impleaded as parties to the present suit.
3. It is pertinent to note that plaintiff is suing for partition of two properties stated to belong to her father Munna Khan. Munna Khan is claimed to have died intestate and as per plaintiff, he left behind his wife Bashiran/D-8, four daughters (i.e. plaintiff and D-5 to D-7) and one son/Mohd. Saleem.
4. Mohd. Saleem had predeceased Munna Khan. Mohd. Saleem in turn had left behind his wife/D-4 and six children. Three of them were impleaded as D-1 to D-3. The other three are now proposed to be brought on record as D-9 to D-11.
5. Since the parties are *Sunni* Muslims, vide last order, it was opined that the said individuals i.e. proposed D-9 to D-11 are necessary parties for complete adjudication of the *lis* before this court. This has

prompted the plaintiff to move the present application.

6. Considering the above and keeping in mind the submissions made by counsel for proposed D-9 to D-11, the above individuals are impleaded as parties to the present suit to be arrayed as D-9 to D-11.
7. Application is disposed off.
8. Amended memo of parties filed with the application is taken on record.

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9. Counsel for D-1 to D-4 and D-8 accepts notice on behalf of D-9 to D-11. He, on instructions, submits that D-9 to D-11 would support the case of D-1 to D-4 and D-8 and would not like recalling of any witnesses or leading of any evidence in the matter. It is pertinent to note that D-1 to D-4 and D-8 are opposing the suit on the ground of two sets of gift deeds and it is submitted that D-9 to D-11 are adopting the entire defence taken by the said defendants. The said submissions are taken on record.
10. Parties submit that in view of the above, the matter can be decided based on record.
11. Submissions heard on behalf of parties.
