(AN APPLICATION TO GRANT PERMISSION TO TAKE SPECIMEN THUMB IMPRESSION AND SIGNATURE IN GURMUKHI SCRIPT OF DEFENDANTS BIKRAMJIT SINGH U/S 151 CPC FILE BY COUNSEL FOR PLAINTIFF.)

Vide this order, this Court shall dispose of an application to grant permission to take specimen thumb impression and signature in gurmukhi script of defendants bikramjit singh u/s 151 CPC.

In the present application the plaintiff has pleaded that on perusal of the contents of the application, it is revealed that application to examine expert witness for the comparison of signature and thumb impression of Bikramjit Singh is already been allowed by this Court on 15.09.2025. The mortgage deed dt. 23.11.2015 in question bears the signature of Gurmukhi as well as English and thumb impression of Bikramjit Singh. Further it is mentioned that perusal of the file shows that there are only signature in English appended by the defendant on documents. There are neither any thumb impression nor any signautre of Bikramjit Singh in Gurmukh on any of the document filed in the Court. Further it is mentioned that principle of science of handwrting the signature in Gurmukh can be compared only with Gurmukh Signature and also the thumb impression are also required for comparison purpose. Hence, the present application filed.

On the other hand counsel for defendant in his reply to pplication to grant permission to take specimen thumb impression and signature in gurmukhi script of defendants bikramjit singh u/s 151 CPC

has pleaded that mortgage deed has not been proved on the file. Remaining all other averments as put forth by the plaintiffs in the plaint are false, frivolous. It is therefore prayed that same may kindly be dismissed, in the interest of justice, equity and fairplay.

The Learned counsels for both the parties have argued on the lines of their respective pleadings, application and reply.

This Court has heard the arguments by learned counsels for both the parties and perused the case file meticulously with their able assistance. Judicial file reveals that there are only signature in English appended by the defendant on documents. There are neither any thumb impression nor any signature of Paramjit Singh in Gurmukh on any of the documents. Therefore the present application is allowed and disposed off. Now case stands adjourned to 04.11.2025 for taking specimen signature in gurmukhi and thumb impression.
