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Summary suit: **Under Order XXXVII of the Code of Civil Procedure**
1908 for recovery of amount of Rs. 2,50,000/-

The present summary suit is instituted to recover an amount of
Rs. 2,50,000/- alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

Brief facts of the plaintiff's case is as under:-

02. The plaintiff is the proprietor of Sheetal Health Care Services, a registered supplier/distributor of cardiac stents, PTCA balloons, spinal implants and other medical devices. The defendant runs Hope Hospital and Ayushman Nagpur Hospital and their respective pharmacies. According to the plaintiff, from April 2023 onwards the defendant regularly placed oral purchase orders for supply of medical devices. The plaintiff supplied the goods from time to time and invoices were raised accordingly. Initially, payments were allegedly made, creating confidence between the parties. Subsequently, despite acceptance of the goods, the defendant allegedly failed to pay the outstanding amount of rs.2,02,724/-. A legal notice dated 03.02.2025 demanding payment was served but no payment was made by the defendant. Hence, the present suit.

03. Suit summons were issued to defendants under Order 37 Rule 2 of C.P.C. He appeared in the matter but failed to file lieu to defend application till date.

This suit coming before Smt. M. M. More/Pawde 02nd Jt. Civil Judge, Jr.Dn., Nagpur for the final disposal on 13th day of July, 2026 in the presence of learned advocate for the plaintiff and defendant. It is hereby ordered that:

ORDER

1. The suit is decreed with costs.
2. The defendant do pay an amount of Rs.2,02,724/-
(Rupees Two Lac Two Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty
Four Only) to the plaintiff with future interest at the rate
of 12.00 % per annum from the date of suit till its
realization.
3. Decree be drawn up accordingly.
