Fresh execution petition received on assignment. It be checked & registered.

Present: Sh. Anirudh Sharma, Id. Counsel for DH. (appearing through VC)

Heard. Perused.

Let report of Civil Nazir be called for the next date of hearing.

Though the present execution petition has been filed within two years from the date of the order passed vide order dated **23.02.2026 in LCA no.60/26** by the learned Labour Court, it is pertinent to note that the Judgment Debtor/Municipal Corporation of Delhi (JD/MCD) is a government agency and also the employer of the Decree Holder (DH). In view of the same, and in the considered opinion of this Court, it is appropriate that a notice of the present execution petition be issued to the JD/MCD to afford an opportunity of response and compliance.

Accordingly, let notice of the execution petition be issued to the Judgment Debtor/MCD on filing PF, returnable on **10.04.2026**.

Steps be taken within two weeks from today. DH is also directed to provide the BMID number, Ward, Zone and the name of department of employee/DH alongwith PF in the form of affidavit (if already not mentioned in the petition).

The Nazir is directed to issue notice to the JD/MCD only if the particulars of the DH/employee as mentioned above are duly provided in the form of affidavit or already mentioned in the execution petition. In case any affidavit has been filed in this regard, a copy of the said affidavit shall also be annexed with the notice along with the petition for ready reference and proper compliance.

It is made clear that objections or calculation, if any, on behalf of JD be positively filed on or before the next date of hearing with advance copy to the opposite party. A copy of this order be also annexed with notice to the JD.
