Part arguments on the application under Order VII Rule 11 r/w Sec. 151 CPC, dated 13.07.2017, are heard.

After arguing partly, the Ld. counsel for the defendants has not pressed his aforesaid application and has prayed for withdrawal of the same.

In view of the submissions of the Ld. counsel for the defendants, the said application is dismissed as withdrawn.

1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree of declaration, in respect of the property bearing No.997, Gali No.20, Subhash Mohalla, North Ghonda, Delhi-110 053, as claimed in the plaint ?

2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree of possession in respect of the aforesaid suit property, as claimed in the plaint ?

3. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree of mandatory injunction, as claimed in the plaint ?

4. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree of permanent injunction, as claimed in the plaint ?

5. Relief.

No other issue arises or is pressed by the parties at this stage. List of witnesses be filed by the parties within two weeks. Affidavits of the witnesses of the plaintiff, as well as the defendants, be filed on or before the next date of hearing. Advance copies of the same be supplied to the Ld. Counsels for the opposite parties, one week prior to the next date of hearing.
