I am brother of the deceased and the complainant. I have no objection to grant of regular bail to the accused/applicant subject to condition that he shall not disturb our peaceful life.

Applicant/accused has been charged u/s 306 IPC. Co-accused Vikas, Neelam and Savitri were discharged by the learned Predecessor vide order dated 28.10.2016. All the accused including applicant were discharged for the offences u/s 498-A/304-B IPC. Only applicant/accused was charged u/s 306 IPC. Said order has been challenged by complainant before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The impugned order has been stayed. This has resulted in stay of whole trial. Applicant/accused is languishing in jail. Next date before Hon'ble High Court is 27.07.2017. He has been released on interim bail also

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and he has not misused the said liberty.

Ld. Counsel submits that treatment of mother of applicant/accused is still going on and presence of applicant/accused is required. He submits that applicant undertakes to follow all the directions as may be imposed.

Considering all facts and circumstances, and statement of complainant, applicant/accused is admitted to regular bail on furnishing a personal bond in sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount and subject to the conditions that he shall not contact complainant and other witnesses and shall not try to influence them. Further, he shall not disturb peaceful life of complainant and his family members. He shall appear regularly on each date of hearing.

Put up on date fixed i.e. 05.08.2017.
