Bail application put up today before me being duty Judge. Chemical report has been received. Copy which has been filed by the police today. Perusal of which shows that the sample of recovered substance found to be containing Alprazolam salt which comes under the preview of NDPS Act and the quantity of salt calculated on the basis of average weight of one tablet comes out to be 13.44 grams which falls under the non-commercial category.

2 The applicant has already been granted interim bail by the concerned court on 31.10.2019 subject to the conditions that the order will remain operative till the receipt of chemical report as to contents of intoxicant and in the event of recovery falling in the commercial quantity, bail order shall become in operative. But in this case the recovery of intoxicant falls in non-commercial category. So, there does not seem any reason for cancellation of the interim bail already granted to the applicant. So, interim bail is hereby made absolute subject to the same terms and conditions. Bail bonds and surety bonds have already been furnished. The bail application stands disposed of. Record be sent to the court concerned for the purpose of consignment.
