Present:- Sh. Manish Tanwar, Ld. Counsel for all the applicants/petitioners alongwith all the applicants/petitioners (in PC No. 28/2025).
Sh. Manoj Kumar, Ld. Counsel for non-applicant/respondent no. 2 (in PC No. 28/2025) alongwith non-applicant/respondent no. 2 in person (who is to stand as a surety).

1. This is an application for issuance, in terms of judgment and order dated 26.12.2025 passed in PC No. 28/2025, Letters of Administration in favour of applicants/petitioners in respect of estate of deceased late Sh. Lucky son of late Sh. Bansi Lal i.e. Locker No. 42B maintained with the State Bank of India, Paharganj Branch, 3/6, Desh Bandhu Gupta Road, Paharganj, New Delhi.
2. Record shows that the applicants/petitioners have already filed an Administration/surety bond wherein Smt. Ramfali Widow of late Sh. Bansi Lal has stood as a surety. Smt. Ramfali (who was arrayed as respondent no. 2 in PC No. 28/2025) is present today in the court as a surety.
3. With this application, the applicants/petitioners have already filed original e-court fees receipt of Rs. 28,300/-, @ 4% of the value of the subject property. Reader to get the same locked, if not already locked.
4. Applicants/Petitioners as well as surety are present today in the court and have produced their identity proofs. Surety in person submits that she is financially sound to pay an amount of Rs. 07,07,361/- in discharge of the bond. Surety in person further submits that she is lawful owner and in possession of the property bearing No. H. No. 1160, Khasr No. 135/19, Ground Floor, gali no. 33, BLK-B, Sant Nagar, Burari vide documents namely GPA, Agreement, affidavit, receipt all dated 01.05.1987.
5. Separate statements of the applicants/petitioners, surety and Ld. Counsel

for applicants/petitioners have been recorded.

6. Having considered the statements of applicants/petitioners, surety and Ld. counsel recorded and the documents produced by the surety, this court is satisfied that the administration/surety bond Ex P-1 is in order and is thus accepted.

7. Let the necessary certificate in terms of judgment and order dated 26.12.2025 passed in PC no. 28/2025 be issued in favour of all the applicants/petitioners with direction to exhibit inventories and accounts in terms of Section 317 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925. The misc. application (MPC no. 11/2026) is disposed off accordingly. With disposal of the misc. application, all other pendings applications have also been disposed off as have become infructuous.

8. Misc. file pertaining to MPC No. 11/26 be consigned to Record Room after due compliance. Copy of this order be placed in file pertaining to PC No. 28/2025 and be consigned to Record Room as per rules.
