This is an application seeking grant of anticipatory bail filed u/s 482 on behalf of applicant/accused.

Reply to the application is also filed by the IO. Copy of the same also stands supplied to the Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Submissions are also heard on the application from both the sides.

In the present case the case FIR has been registered for the commission of offence punishable u/s 80/85/108/3(5) BNS in relation to the death of deceased Madhu which took place within 7 years of marriage and as per the allegation of the complainant i.e. brother of the deceased was subjected to continuous cruelty, harassment and dowry related demands by her husband and other in laws.

Since the perusal of the reply of the IO reveals that the investigation of the case is in initial stage and the role and involvement of the applicant vis a vis the allegation of the harassment, cruelty and demands of dowry, is yet to be ascertained and the perusal of police complaint of the complainant and the statement of the complainant and his sister recorded before the Ld. Magistrate u/s 183 BNSS also prima facie does not disclose any specific allegations regarding the alleged

cruelty and harassment of the deceased in relation to the dowry demand at the hands of the applicant/accused except a general statement that the deceased victim was being subjected to cruelty and harassment in relation to demand of dowry by her husband and other members of the family, the applicant/accused is directed to immediately join the investigation on service of a proper notice by the IO in that regard.

Put up for final disposal of the application on **08.06.2026**.

The IO is also hereby restrained from taking any coercive action against the accused till NDOH.
