Today the matter is fixed for PE.

PW Dr. Arvind has not appeared despite repeated calls and waiting. It is already 3.45 PM, no further wait is justified.

Let, bailable warrant be issued against witness PW Dr. Arvind in the sum of Rs. 5000/- and one surety of the like amount to be executed through IO/SHO concerned.

Dr. Sarvagya has appeared on behalf of Dr. Abhishek Sheh, however, she is discharged unexamined since she had submitted that she had never worked with Dr. Abhishek Sheh and she cannot identify his hand writing and his signatures. She had brought one photocopy of the attendance register of the relevant period in which signatures of Dr. Abhishek Sheh is purportedly there, however, same has not been attested by the MS of the concerned hospital. She has further submitted that there are no doctors available in their hospital who could identify the said signatures as no one who had worked with him, is currently working in the hospital.

Let fresh summons be issued to Dr. Abhishek Sheh through the MS, GTB Hospital alongwith a direction that if there is no other doctor who could identify the signatures and handwriting of the witness,

then the concerned clerk alongwith the duly attested copy and the original attendance register of the relevant period shall appear on behalf of Dr. Abhishek Sheh through IO/ SHO concerned for the next date of hearing.

Let the copy of MLC no. 44221/14117 be annexed alongwith the summons.
