Reply to the above said application has been filed by
IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld.
Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that
applicant/accused is in JC since 27.11.2024 and he has been
falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that
there is no single iota of allegation in the FIR against the
applicant/accused that he ever demanded any dowry from the
deceased or harassed her for dowry. It is further submitted that
nothing has been stated in the FIR that soon before the death or
after the marriage deceased was subjected to cruelty or
harassment in connection with any demand of dowry. It is further
submitted that there is nothing on record to show that the
deceased was subjected to cruelty soon before her death or there
was any demand from her since the day of her marriage. It is

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further submitted that there are no specific allegations of any cruelty or harassment meted out to the deceased person by the applicant/accused, just before the death. It is further submitted that nothing of that kind was ever made at any point of time, when the deceased herself was alive and residing with the applicant/accused at her matrimonial home prior to the registration of the present case. It is further submitted that FSL report also shows that there is no sign of cruelty on the body of the deceased persons. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 1131/2024 has been registered at PS S. P. Badli U/s. 85/86 BNS. The FIR in the present case on the statement of mother of deceased Smt. Kajal wherein she has leveled specific allegations of demand of dowry

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against applicant/accused **Sagar**. Perusal of the FIR as well as statement of prosecution witnesses goes on to show that specific allegations of cruelty and demand of dowry articles as well as taunting with respect to articles given in dowry have been leveled against applicant/accused **Sagar**. Further, he cannot be treated on parity with other co-accused persons for the same reason. The trial of the present case has not been initiated as charges are yet to be framed and material witnesses are yet to be examined.

Keeping in view of above discussion as well as keeping in view of seriousness of allegations and also considering the seriousness and gravity of the offences alleged against applicant/accused namely this court is not inclined to grant bail to applicant/accused namely Sagar. The present bail application stands dismissed, accordingly. Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties. The present bail application file be tagged with the main case file.
