All the four accused persons are present on bail.
Sh. H.P Sharma, Id counsel for accused Ankit Kaushik.

In the morning Sh. Satinder Singh Bawa, Id counsel for accused Kapil Kushik had appeared and they had submitted that he does not want to cross examine PW-1 qua accused Kapil Kaushik. It was further submitted by him that he had also been appointed as amicus curiae for accused Parvesh and submitted that he may be discharged since he does not want to continue to represent accused Parvesh as amicus curiae.

Accordingly the counsel, who was assisting Ms. Kamakshi Id counsel for accused Kapil during the cross examination of PW-1 SI Sukhbir Singh in case FIR No. 116/2011, P.S Crime Branch, titled as State Vs. Deepak Kaushik etc was appointed as amicus curiae for accused Parvesh in the present case and was directed to provide his particulars in the present case. However said Advocate did not turn up either to give his particulars or to cross examine the witness present today in this case and when Msk Kamakshi was contacted telephonically by the Reader of the Court she told that she did not know the said Advocate. In these circumstances the submission of Sh. Surender Singh Bawa qua his discharge in the present case is kept pending for consideration.

Case is fixed for cross-examination of PW-1 ASI Rajbir Singh. However, an application has been moved on behalf of Sh. Bobby Lau, Id. counsel for accused Deepak Kaushik (A-1) seeking exemption from personal appearance on the ground that he is not well. Heard. The present case is one of the oldest cases pertaining to this Court and today it is listed for cross examination of PW-1 ASI Rajbir Singh. On the earlier date also, it was deferred for cross-examination. As this case is one of

the oldest matters, wherein Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has given direction to deal it on priority basis and timely reports are being sent, this Court is of the view that no further opportunity for cross-examination can be granted to accused Deepak. Hence, the application is dismissed.

Cross examination of PW-1 carried out by Sh. H.P Sharma, Id counsel for accused Ankit Kaushik. Since remaining accused persons did not opt to cross examine the said witness despite opportunity given to them, hence cross examination of the said witness on behalf of remaining witness is recorded as Nil. PW-1 is discharged.
