ARGUMENTS ON CHARGE

Arguments on the point of charge heard.

Ld. Counsels have argued that accused persons have been falsely implicated and they have nothing to do with the alleged offence.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has argued that on 08.09.2023, at unknown time at near Public Toilet situated in the area of Airport Metro Building, Delhi, both accused persons in furtherance of their common intention committed murder of Ajay Kumar @ Panditji by strangulating him with the help of gamchha and thereafter, threw his dead body in a drainage situated near Mukhmailpur Pulia, Kailash Farm, Hiranki Road with the intention of screening themselves from legal punishment.

Record perused.

After having gone through the FIR, statements of the witnesses recorded u/s 161 Cr.P.C. and other material and documents available on the record, a prima facie case U/s 302/201/34 IPC is made out against both accused persons.

Accordingly, charge for the offence U/s 302/201/34 IPC has been framed against both accused persons to which they

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pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Let summons be issued to the witnesses mentioned at Sl. No.1 & 2 through SHO/IO concerned for the next date of hearing.

Notice be also issued to IO and MHC(M) for the next date of hearing.
