This is an application filed by applicant/accused – Sajeb
seeking grant of anticipatory bail.

The Incident :

1. 10-12 days prior to 23.11.2025 (date of providing of first information to the police), Asad, first cousin of complainant – Yusuf, had come to visit Yusuf from District Kashganj, UP. At about 10:40 p.m. on 23.11.2025, when the complainant and Asad were sitting on the stairs of a shop situated in Gali No. 3, North-East Block, Vishnu Garden, Khyala, there came a boy named – Sajeb (applicant/accused). Sajeb was accompanied with two boys. Sajeb asked for the mobile phone of Asad, upon which Asad informed Sajeb that his mobile was not recharged and consequently, he refused to give Sajeb his mobile. Upon this refusal, a quarrel ensued between Sajeb and Asad. The quarrel escalated into a fight. The

complainant intervened to put off the fight. During the fight, applicant/accused – Sajeb took out a knife and stabbed Asad in his belly.

2. It is averred in the application and argued by the Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused that the applicant/accused was not present at the spot at the time when the alleged offence was committed. It is also averred and argued that the complainant has instituted the present false case to extort money from the applicant/accused.

3. The applicant/accused is named in the FIR. The victim had received stab injury in his belly. The applicant/accused has been accused by the victim by name, to have stabbed him. The *alibi* raised is for the applicant to prove. Hence, reasonable grounds exist to infer that applicant/accused had committed the reported offence. Hence, the present application seeking grant of anticipatory bail is dismissed.
