File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C. for grant of interim bail for a period of 30 days moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Lakhan**.

Reply to the interim bail application has been received from SI Radhesh Kumar.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC . It is further submits that son of applicant/accused has been expired on 07.12.2022 at Deep Chand Bandhu Hospital, Ashok Vihar, Delhi and the applicant/accused being the father have to attend last rituals of his son and prayer is made out for grant of interim bail application for a period of 30 days.

On the other hand, ld. Substitute Additional PP for State has opposed the interim bail application and prayer is made out for dismissal of the bail application.

Heard.

Keeping in view of the fact that son of the applicant/accused Lakhan had expired on 07.12.2022 and his last rituals are to be carried and also considering the report of IO, on humanitarian ground the applicant/accused Lakhan be released on interim bail for a period of 2 weeks only on his furnishing personal

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bond in the sum of Rs. 35,000 with one surety in the like amount. The applicant/accused Lakhan is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately after the expiry of period of interim bail and concerned jail superintendent shall send his report immediately thereafter. However, he is further directed not to threaten the prosecution witnesses or tamper with evidence or indulge in any such crime. The applicant/accused shall share his phone's live location as and when required by the IO. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the interim bail granted to him shall be liable to be canceled . The interim bail application is disposed off accordingly.
