File taken up today as an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C. for extension of interim bail for a period of two weeks' has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Lakhan**.

Reply to the application has been filed.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that applicant/accused had got the interim bail from this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 08.12.2022 for two weeks on the ground that his son had got expired on 07.12.2022 and being the father he had to attend last rituals of his son. The said period is expired on 23.12.2022. It is further submitted by ld. counsel that now the applicant's wife is suffering from Neurology disorder disease because of which she is facing problems of seizure disorder due to CVA i.e. Cerebro Vascular Accident. He has further submitted that her treatment is going on from Aruna Asaf Ali Govt. Hospital. Copy of her medical documents are annexed with the application. He has further submitted that due to above syndrome she was got admitted in hospital on 12.12.2022 and got discharge from the hospital on 19.12.2022. He has further submitted that earlier the applicant's son was taking care of her but after his death there is no male member in his family who will take care of her wife. Therefore, he has prayed for extension of interim bail

of applicant/accused for taking care of her wife.

On the other hand, ld. Additional PP for the State has opposed the interim bail application and prayer is made out for dismissal of the same.

Heard.

Keeping in view of the fact that the applicant's son is expired recently and now his wife is suffering from seizure disorder and there is no other male member in his family for taking care of his wife, on humanitarian ground **the interim bail of applicant/accused Lakhan is extended for a period of two weeks on the same terms and condition as per order dated 08.12.2022.** The applicant/accused Lakhan is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent immediately after the expiry of period of interim bail and concerned jail superintendent shall send his report immediately thereafter. The interim bail application is disposed off accordingly.
