File taken up today on an application U/s. 439 Cr. P. C for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Lakhan**.

Present: Sh. Sanjay Jindal, ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Sohan Singh Negi, ld. counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that applicant/accused is in JC and wife of applicant/accused is suffering from Neurology diseases. It is further submitted that wife of applicant was got admitted in the hospital on 12.01.2022 and got discharged from 19.12.2022, due to the above said disease the applicant's wife needs a regular treatment and if she will not get proper treatment, there may be chances of brain damage. It is further submitted that applicant/accused had not misused the liberty when the interim bail of applicant/accused was granted and prayer is made out for grant of bail application.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State has strongly opposed the bail application and submits that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature and prayer is made out for dismissal of the bail application.

Heard.

Vide order dated 08.12.2022 this Court had already granted interim bail for a period of two weeks, thereafter interim bail of applicant/accused had already been extended for a period of two weeks vide order dated 22.12.2022. This court has already given sufficient time to applicant/accused for taking care of his wife and also

considering the fact that merely the ground that he has timely surrendered after expiry of interim bail is not sufficient to extend regular bail, the present bail application stands dismissed. **Copy of order be given dasti to the concerned parties.** The present bail application file be tagged with the main file.
