This application for grant of interim bail u/s 439 Cr.P.C. for a period of one month moved on behalf of applicant/accused Lakhan is placed before me in terms of order No.Judl./Bail/North/RC/2021/24637-661 dated 30/06/2020 of Id. District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi. The bail application is taken-up through video conferencing on CISCO WEBEX Meeting APP. with the consent of the parties.

Present in Court: None for parties.

Reply to the bail application has been received from the P.S. Copy of the same has been sent to Id counsel for the applicant at his whatsapp number 7982103625 by the Reader of the Court through his whatsapp number 8287701426.

It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused that the applicant/accused is in J.C. since 09/09/2020. He has further submitted that wife of the applicant/accused is seriously ill for the last three years and is under treatment at Deep Chand Bandhu Hospital, Ashok Vihar, New Delhi. He has further submitted that now the condition of the wife of the applicant/accused is very serious as her whole body is getting swelling and she is not in a position to walk properly and that due to COVID 19 disease, her treatment has been stopped. Id. Counsel has further submitted that applicant/accused is the only member in the family and his presence is required for getting his wife treated. He has lastly prayed for grant of interim bail for a period of one month to the applicant/accused.

Per contra, it is argued by Id. Substitute Addl. PP for the State that the allegations levelled against the applicant/accused are serious and grave in nature and there are other family members in the family of the applicant/accused to take care of her.

On being put specific query as to whether there is any other member in the family of the applicant/accused, Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused has stated that there is one son in the family of the applicant/accused but he is residing separately.

Heard. Though the son of the applicant/accused is residing separately, but his relations are not stated to be strained with the applicant/accused or his wife and he can take care of his mother. Keeping in view of the fact that it is a case related to honour killing, I am of the considered opinion that this is not a fit case for grant of interim bail to the applicant/accused, hence the present application is dismissed and is disposed of accordingly.
