

BA-3-2024 State Vs. Gurjant Singh

1. This order of mine shall dispose of application for regular bail filed under Section 437 Cr.P.C. PS Kotfatta on behalf of accused/applicant Gurjant Singh.
2. The present FIR No. 01 dated 01.01.2024 under Section 379/411 of IPC PS Kotfatta was registered against the accused/applicant Gurjant Singh. As per the prosecution story the accused/applicant Gurjant Singh in connivance with the truck drivers sell diesel oil to the general customers at a slightly lower rate than the market rate.
3. Notice of this bail application was given to the learned APP, who did not file any reply but opposed the bail application orally and record was also summoned.
4. On the other hand Ld. Defence counsel submitted that accused/applicant having no hand in the alleged crime and he is innocent. He further argued that accused/applicant has involved falsely in the present case and no recovery was made from the possession of the accused.
5. Arguments heard and record perused. As per allegations levelled against the accused/applicant Gurjant Singh, he has allegedly committed offence under Sections 379/411 of IPC. Accused/applicant Gurjaant Singh is already in custody since 01.01.2024. Conclusion of investigation and presentation of challan would take sufficient long time. If the accused/applicant Gurjant Singh is kept behind the bars then it would be a burden on state exchequer. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant in custody for indefinite period. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and in the interest of justice, present bail application stands allowed to the effect that accused/applicant Gurjant Singh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing his bail bonds in sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release warrant of the accused Gurjant Singh be issued. The application stands disposed of. Papers be attached with the remand papers.
