ORDER:

This is a **first** regular bail application filed on behalf of **bail applicant** in the above referred FIR case.

2. **Notice** of bail application was issued to the State through Learned Additional Public Prosecutor of the State, who put in appearance and contested the bail application.

3. Report of Ahlmad has also received, vide which it is reported that no other bail application is pending or decided as per the website of Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana, Chandigarh.

4 The police record was requisitioned and perused.

5. I have heard the Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State and the Learned Counsel for bail-applicant and have gone through the

police record.

6. From the record, it comes out to surface that on **07.03.2023** police party while on patrol duty, were going towards Mohalla Kaintha, Dasuya from Dharampura Mohalla and when they reached little ahead of 'Dhir Poultry Farm, meantime one clean shaven person was spotted coming from opposite side, who on observing police party present there got perplexed and tried to turn back and dropped glazed envelope taking out it from left pocket of his trousers. Therefore, **bail applicant** was intercepted on the basis of suspicion and after making statutory compliances under the Act, from glazed envelope dropped by **bail applicant**, **45 grams intoxicant powder** was recovered and parcel was prepared and taken into possession.

7. It is evident that **bail-applicant** was arrested on **07.03.2023**. The recovery effected from **bail applicant**, in this case, is **45 grams of intoxicant powder**, the active salt of which is reported to be **Trematode Hydrochloride** as per report of FSL. The final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. stood filed. The conclusion of trial shall take sufficient time. **The bail-applicant** is in custody since the day of his arrest i.e. **07.03.2023**. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances, I deem it proper to grant **regular bail** to bail-applicant, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of **Rs.50,000/-** with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of **Ilaqa Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate**.

8. The observations made by the undersigned, vide this order will have no reflection on merits.
