

Paras Singh vs. State

1. This order of mine shall dispose of bail application u/s 438 Cr.P.C.filed by the applicant in the FIR No.8 dated 22.1.2020 u/s 399, 402 IPC, PS City Rampura, Distt.Bathinda.

2. Ld.counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant was not apprehended on the spot nor there is anything on record to show that he also had any case registered against him earlier. Nothing is to be recovered from him but he is still ready to join the investigation. He has prayed for acceptance of bail application.

3. On the other hand, Ld.APP has opposed this bail application alleging that present applicant alongwith Jaspreet Singh, Gurditta Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Sarabjit Kaur, Binder Singh were planning to commit dacoity and pursuant to the secret information received, Jaspreet Singh, Gurditta Singh and Gurpreet Singh were apprehended and sword, iron rod and iron dah were recovered from them but the other three persons had managed to escape. He has prayed for the dismissal of the bail application.

4. I have considered the submissions made by learned counsel for applicant as well as learned Addl.PP for the State.

5. Perusal of the file reveals that instant case was registered the present applicants alongwith Sarabjit Kaur, Honey as well as Jaspreet Singh, Gurdita Singh and Gurpreet Singh that they were planning to commit a dacoity being armed with deadly weapons on Mehraj Road, pursuant to which Jaspreet Singh, Gurditta Singh and Gurpreet Singh were apprehended

an iron rod, dah and sword were recovered from them but the other three persons had managed to escape. There is nothing on record to show that the other three persons who managed to escape included the present applicant nor there is anything on record to show that what weapon he was armed which is to be recovered from him. I find that custodial interrogation of applicant is not required. Thus, applicant is admitted on interim bail. He is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer within 2 days from today and to cooperate in it. In that eventuality, he will be released on interim bail by the arresting officer on furnishing of bail bonds to his satisfaction. Applicant shall comply with the conditions under section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Copy of this order be sent to the concerned quarter. Report of Investigating Officer qua joining of investigation by the accused, be submitted on **10.02.2020**.
