

Ramesh Bajaj Vs. Punjab Pollution Control Board. (BA-298-19)

Bail application received by entrustment. It be registered. Ld. Counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant has been summoned in a complaint case by the Court of Ms. Balwinder Kaur Dhaliwal, PCS, SDJM, Dera Bassi. He further submitted that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and no offence was committed by him. Custodial interrogation is not provided for in a complaint case. As such no useful purpose would be served by taking the applicant in custody. He further submitted that applicant is ready to appear before Ld. Trial Court and furnishing bail bonds. Heard. Notice of the application be issued to respondent/Board for 14.2.2019. Record of Trial Court be also called for that date. In the meanwhile applicant/accused is directed to appear before Trial Court within 7 days from today and learned Trial Court is directed to admit him to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bond to its satisfaction, subject to the conditions laid down U/S 438(2) Cr.P.C.
