ORDER :

This order shall dispose of first application for regular bail filed
by the applicant-accused, particulars of which are given above.

2. As per the case of the prosecution, there are the allegations against the applicant-accused that he, along with co-accused, hatched a criminal conspiracy with a view to cheat The Hisar Jind Co-operative Milk producers Union Ltd. Milk Plant, Jind by labeling the sticker of its name on the adulterated 'Ghee' and in pursuance of said criminal conspiracy, applicant-accused along with co-accused was also involved in preparing adulterated 'Ghee'.

3. Notice of the application was given to the State through Public Prosecutor. Reply to the application was filed wherein the contents of the FIR have been reiterated.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the accused-applicant and learned Public Prosecutor and have gone through the case file carefully.

5. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has argued that the applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 08.01.2026. It has been further argued that nothing is to be recovered from the possession of accused-applicant. It has been further argued that investigation in the present case has already been completed and challan has also been presented before the court. It has been further argued that co-accused Anand has already been granted concession of regular bail by the Hon'ble High Court, vide order dated 06.07.2026 passed in CRM-M-18272-2026 (O & M) titled as 'Anand vs. State of Haryana'. It has been further argued that completion of trial of case shall take a long time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bar.

It has, therefore, been proved that accused-applicant may be released on bail on the ground of parity.

6. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor for the State has opposed the bail application by arguing that allegations against the accused-applicant are quite serious.

7. As per the case of the prosecution, there are allegations against the accused-applicant with regard to commission of offences of cheating and preparing the adulterated ghee in order to sell the same in the open market. Perusal of record reveals that admittedly, accused-applicant has not been arrested from the spot and he has been arrested only on the disclosure statement of co-accused. It is also admitted fact that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the accused-applicant and the ghee alleged to be adulterated has been recovered from co-accused Sunil. Applicant-accused is in custody since 11.12.2025. Investigation in the present case has already been completed and challan has also been presented before court. Trial of the case which is still at nascent stage, is likely to take long time to conclude. As the case of the present applicant-accused is on the same footings as that of co-accused Anand, who has already been granted concession of regular bail by the Hon'ble High Court, vide order dated 06.07.2026, therefore, on the ground of parity, present first bail application of the accused-applicant is hereby allowed and the accused-applicant is admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/-

with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. A copy of this order be sent to the court of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate for compliance. Bail application file be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
