The present Misc. Application has been filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 11 days in preferring the appeal against the order dated 31.10.2025 passed in Original Suit No. 375 of 1996 by the Court of Civil Judge (J.D.), Chhibramau, District Kannauj.

Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submits that due to the illness of the applicant, she could not prefer the appeal within time. In support of the statement, the relevant documents have also been filed.

Learned counsel appearing for the opposite party submits that the order was passed on 31.10.2025, whereas the present appeal has been filed on 11.12.2025, and the applicant, in the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, has not explained the delay as required by law.

Heard and perused the record.

From the perusal of the application, it transpires that a statement has been made along with the affidavit to the effect that due to the illness of the applicant, she could not prefer the appeal within the period of limitation. The application is supported by relevant documents. Considering the statement made in the application as well as the supporting documents, the application is allowed subject to payment of costs.

ORDER.

Misc. Application No. 117/74/2025, **Asha Begum alias Ayesha Begum vs. Anwari Begum & Ors.**, is allowed. The delay in filing the appeal is condoned subject to payment of **costs of Rs. 750/-**. Let the appeal be placed **for admission on 02.09.2026**.
