The report of SHO, P.S. Sector-29, Gurugram sought in terms of application for releasing of vehicle bearing no. **HR-55-AR-7441** on superdari, moved by applicant, is perused. The police has not objected to release the above said vehicle in favor of registered owner.

In view of report submitted by the Police, the said vehicle bearing no. **HR-55-AR-7441** in question is ordered to be released in favour of registered owner/applicant/AR namely **Devi Dayal**, on furnishing superdari bonds in the sum of **Rs. 2,00,000/-** with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of SHO concerned, with undertaking not to alienate the same without prior permission of the court and to produce the same in the court as and when required and not to change its colour and condition till final disposal of the main case. SHO concerned is directed to retain the RC of vehicle in question and same be produced at the time of filing of challan. A copy of this order be sent to SHO concerned for necessary compliance. The SHO concerned is directed to furnish the superdarinama along with challan. The papers be tagged with the case concerned.
