

Paramjit Singh and others versus State of Punjab and others

**ORDER:**

1. Vide this order, I intend to dispose of two second anticipatory bail applications, both filed by same applicants namely Paramjit Singh, Daljit Singh, Harnoor Singh and Jaskaran Singh, bearing No.2953-2020 and 2955-2020, period of first anticipatory bail application passed in blanket bail applications having already expired.

3. Heard. ASI Gurmukh Singh of PS Kotwali has come present and made a statement that two complaints moved by complainants namely Rakha Singh son of Attar Singh and Paraminder Singh son of Natha Singh against four applicants namely Paramjit Singh, Harnoor Singh, Jaskaran Singh and Daljit Singh have already been recommended for registration of FIR u/s 406 IPC by DSP City-I, Bathinda, though FIR has not been registered till date.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant has stated that if case is registered against the applicants, the police may arrest and keep the accused in illegal custody or harass them. He has submitted that three days prior notice may kindly be given in case applicants are required to be arrested in the present FIR.

5. The applicants apprehend that the police may arrest them all of a sudden in the instant case, if case is registered against them. Even as per statement of ASI Gurmukh Singh, two applications moved by Parminder Singh and Rakha Singh have been inquired by DSP (City-I) and he has

recommended for the registration of FIR, though FIR has not been registered so far. The allegations against applicants are that they had taken gold ornaments as well as money from the complainants Rakha Singh and Parminder Singh on interest basis, but on demand by the complainants, the applicants have refused to return the gold as well as money and as such, they have cheated the complainants. FIR has not been registered so far against the applicants. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of three months of the first bail order for which the bail was granted having already expired, if case is registered against the applicants Paramjit Singh, Harnoor Singh, Jaskaran Singh and Daljit Singh at any stage and necessity arises to arrest them, it is ordered that then the Investigating officer would serve three days prior notice to the applicants, so that they may approach court, if so desired. A copy of this order be placed on the file bearing No.2955-2020. Files be consigned to the record room.
