This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru. A.Azaruddin learned Advocate for the petitioner and of Thiru. K.V.Manoharan, learned Public Prosecutor for the State and after hearing the arguments and perused records, this court passed the following...

ORDER

Petition filed U/s. 439 Cr.P.C. Petitioner/Accused prays to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 270, 272, 273, 328, 511 IPC r/w 6(b), 24(1) COTPA Act in Cr.No.406/2022 of Kannamangalam police station. The petitioner/accused was remanded on 04.10.2022.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner/Accused stated that he is an innocent person and not in anyway connected with the above alleged offences, that the investigation is almost over, that the respondent herein had foisted a false case as against the petitioner, that he is having residential address with valuable properties, that the question of absconding or tampering the witness will not arise, that he will abide any condition if imposed by this court in the bail order, that he was remanded on 04.10.2022 and he is in custody for 10 days and he prays for bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor for the State vehemently raised objection for granting bail to the petitioner by stating that he is in possession of 1200 packets of PanMasala worth about Rs.13,600/- . However he has fairly conceded that no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

Heard both sides, records perused. The case was registered against the petitioner/accused for the offences punishable u/s. 270, 272, 273, 328, 511 IPC r/w 6(b), 24(1) COTPA Act. The case of the prosecution was that the petitioner/accused had illegally possession of 1200 packets of Pan Masala worth about Rs.13,600/- .Considering the fact that the no previous case is pending against the petitioner and no serious objection raised by the learned Public prosecutor and on considering the period of incarceration and upon considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court inclines to grant bail to the Petitioner/ accused with condition.

Bail is granted to the petitioner /accused on Strict compliance of the following condition.

1.The Petitioner/Accused shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) before the District Mediation Centre, Tiruvannamalai.

2. The petitioner/ accused is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned Judicial Magistrate Arni.**

3. The petitioner/accused is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police station daily at 10.30 am. for a continuous period of 30 days.

4. The petitioner/accused shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

5. The petitioner/ accused shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
