This is an application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused Sunny.

Reply to the bail application has already been filed.

1. Briefly stated, on 12/06/2025 at around 15:45 PM a PCR Call vide DD No.72A was received at PS Swaroop Nagar that "CALLER KI WIFE AGE-26 YRS NE FANSI LGA LI HAI, NEED HELP" The Call was marked to SI Shankar, who along with HC Sanjay reached at place of incident H.No.492, Gali No. 1 1/2, J- Block, Khadda Colony, Swaroop Nagar, Delhi and found that the deceased namely Hema was lying on the bed and a chunni was hanging from the fan. On enquiry it was revealed that the deceased Hema has hanged herself and it was also revealed that she had a love marriage two years ago with Sunny, applicant herein and she was pregnant of 8 months.

During enquiry, sister and brother of the deceased namely Chanchal Kumari and Karan were made allegation against the in-laws of deceased Hema. After that a Case FIR No. 304/25 U/s 80/85/3(5) BNS was registered against the accused persons.

2. It is argued by Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused

that accused is running in JC since 15.06.2025 and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further argued that applicant and deceased were living happily and there are no circumstances, compelling the deceased to commit suicide.

It is argued that investigation has already been completed and no recovery is to be effected from him, hence, no purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. It is submitted that applicant/accused is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions, which may be imposed. It is prayed that a lenient view be taken.

3. Ld. Additional PP for the State vehemently opposed the bail application submitting that the allegations levelled against the applicant/ accused are very grave and serious in nature. Prayer for dismissal of the application was made.

4. I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused and Ld. Addl. PP for the State.

5. In the present case, Mobile Phone Vivo and two personal dairies of deceased Hema were seized. Whatsapp chats between deceased Hema and accused Sunny were found, in which accused Sunny was pressurizing the deceased for money and also used filthy language with her. Deceased was asked to stay at her parental home despite the fact that she was not on talking terms with her parental family due to the marriage with the applicant/accused. As per report filed by the IO, deceased was 08 months pregnant at the time of her death

Matter is still at the initial stages. Charge is yet to be framed against the applicant/accused and evidence of the material/public witnesses is yet to be recorded. There are grave, and serious allegations against the applicant/accused.

Considering the grave and serious allegations against the applicant/accused, no ground for grant of bail is made out at this stage. The application stands dismissed.

Application is disposed off accordingly.

6. It is clarified that nothing stated herein shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

7. Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused as well as be sent to concerned IO, Ld. Secretary, DLSA (North), through all possible modes, as per rules.
