File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Udayveer Singh**.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Reply to the above said application has already been received.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is a rightful owner of a residential house which is situated at Karaityi, Post Office Shahbad, District Rampur, Up and the said property is constructed on a single floor and is presently in a state of severe disrepair, having undergone progressive deterioration over an extended period. It is further submitted that the structural stability of the house has been gravely undermined, with prominent cracks visible in the walls and ceilings, thereby heightening the risk of an abrupt collapse. It is further submitted that this condition constitutes a serious and immediate danger to adjacent properties and the safety of nearby residents. It is further submitted that photographic evidence depicting the dilapidated state of the property is enclosed. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said

application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 1225/2015 has been registered at PS K. N. K. Marg U/s. 364/302/365/201/120B IPC. The present interim bail application has been moved on the ground of repair of applicant/accused **Udayveer Singh's** house. During the course of arguments Ld. Additional PP for State pointed out that on earlier occasion, interim bail was granted on similar ground. Further, as per the report of IO *“field verification for the repair of the residential house was done and statement of neighbours of applicant/accused was recorded, wherein they stated that nobody used to reside at the given address”*. Thus no ground for grant of interim bail is made out.

Keeping in view of seriousness of allegations leveled against applicant/accused as well as seriousness and gravity of offence alleged against him, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail to applicant / accused **Udayveer Singh**. Interim Bail Application is dismissed accordingly.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. **Copy of order be given dasti to the**
