Reply to the present application has been received from the Office of the Superintendent, Central Jail-10, Sector-19, Rohini, Delhi, wherein it is mentioned that applicant/accused Udayveer Singh has not surrendered before the Jail till date.

Perusal of the file shows that applicant/accused Deepak Jain was released on interim bail vide order dated 26.05.2025 for a period of 15 days from the date of release in pursuance of order dated 06.05.2025 and 19.05.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant that applicant Sh. Deepak Jain had stood surety to accused Udayveer Singh on a previous occasion and that another surety was furnished by applicant/accused at the time of grant of the interim bail of the accused Udayveer Singh given vide order dated 26.05.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

It is further submitted that applicant Mr. Deepak Jain has nothing to do with the non-surrender of accused Udayveer

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Singh as the accused Udayveer Singh had timely surrendered before jail authorities at the expiry of interim bai period when applicant Deepak Jain had stood surety for him, therefore, he prayed that surety documents of applicant may kindly be released and the Court may take action against the present surety.

Keepig in view of the fact applicant / surety Deepak Jain had stood surety to accused Udayveer Singh on an earlier occasion and accused had surrendered in time after expiry of period of interim bail, no useful purpose shall be served by keeping the FDR of applicant / surety on record. Accordingly, let the original FDR filed on behalf of applicant / surety Sh. Deepak Jain be released to him against due acknowledgment as per law. One self attested copy be retained on record.

Application stands disposed off, accordingly.

It is pertinent to mention that as per the reply received from Jail Superintendent concerned, accused Udayveer Singh has not surrendered before jail authorities, despite expiry of period of interim bail given vide order dated 06.05.2025 and 19.05.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, let NBWs be issued against accused Udayveer Singh and notice to his present surety for date already fixed i.e., **29.07.2025**.

Copy of the order be given dasti, as prayed for.
