Both the accused are produced from JC.

Sh Sudheer Shokeen, Ld Counsel for accused Udayaveer.

Case is at the stage of Prosecution evidence.

Sh Deepak Kr Sinha, Manager , BSNL is present. He is discharged unexamined as he has not brought the original CAF forms and requisite call record. He is directed to bring the same, on the next date of hearing.

PW Rajender Yadav is also present. He is discharged unexamined as IO is not present today.

Ms Rachna Yadav, wife of deceased is present with Ld Counsel Ms Mahima Chowdhary.

An application has been filed for on behalf of Ms Rachna Yadav, for release of vehicle bearing no. DL-8CM-5371, white colour, Tata Safari, seized in this case, by the IO.

Report on the said application filed.

It is stated that the above said vehicle was seized by the IO, in this case. It is further contended that investigation is already complete and it is no more required for the purpose of investigation. It is further contended that Rachna Yadav, is the registered owner of the aforesaid vehicle and it is prayed that the said vehicle be released on superdari, to its registered owner, who undertakes to produce the same as and when required during the trial.

On the other hand, it is contended by Ld Addl PP that, this vehicle was recovered at the instance of accused Rajender Yadav and same was seized from the parking of Railway station, Bareilly and the original plate number DL-8CM-5371 was found inside the vehicle, which were seized

separately.

I have gone through the case file. The vehicle is in the name of Rachna Yadav. Photocopy of RC is filed on record. As the investigation is already completed and chargesheet has been filed and case is at the stage of PE, hence the vehicle No. DI-8CM-5371 be released on superdari to its registered owner, on furnishinsh superdaginama in the sum of Rs. 2,00,000, to the satisfaction of the IO, subject to the condition that the applicant will not sell the vehicle without prior permission of the Court and vehicle be produced in the Court as and when required, failing which the superdarginama will be forfeited. It is further directed that the photographs of the vehicle be taken from all aspects, before releasing the same, on superdari.

Application stands disposed of.
