Further reply is filed. As per reply, medical record of wife of
applicant has been verified. It is submitted that patient has been stated to be
stayed in hospital for 5-6 days.

Ld. Public Prosecutor has strongly opposed this interim bail on
the ground that the applicant had been granted interim bail for this purpose of
itself on the last date but he did not get his wife operated.

Ld. Counsel for applicant submits that the operation could not be
done because the medical parameter of the patient were not good enough
for operation at that time. It is further submitted that the applicant shall not
seek interim bail on this ground in future.

Considering all the facts and circumstances, I am of the opinion
that it is necessary for the applicant to be present with his wife at the time
of operation. Accordingly, I admit the applicant Rajender Yadav to interim
bail on furnishing personal bond in sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties in
the like amount for 15 days from his date of release. On completion of 15
days, the applicant shall surrender in the jail.

It is requested by Ld. Counsel for applicant that eyesight of
applicant Rajender Yadav is poor and if he released in the late hours, it
becomes difficult for him to travel. Therefore, it is prayed that Jail Supdt. Is
directed to release the applicant in morning.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
