Both the accused persons namely Udayveer Singh and Rajender Yadav are produced from JC.

Sh.Imtiaz Hussain, Ld. counsel for complainant.

IO Inspector Anil Kumar is absent despite service.

Issue B/W in the sum of Rs.5000/- against Inspector Anil Kumar.

PW-12 Manohar Lal and PW-13 HC Parveen are examined and discharged.

PW HC Ved Prakash has sent exemption request. Request declined.

Issue B/W in the sum of Rs.5000/- against HC Ved Prakash and notice u/s 350 Cr. P.C.

Ld. Counsel for complainant moves an application for personal exemption of PW-9 Vishu Yadav on the ground of illness. Perused. Seen the copy of the medical record. Exemption is opposed by Ld. Counsel for accused. Request declined.

Issue B/W in the sum of Rs.5000/- against PW Vishu Yadav.

Heard on the application for grant of bail moved by Ld. Counsel for accused Rajender Yadav on the ground that he is suffering from AIDS and his wife is suffering from Cancer and there is no one to look after his ailing wife and young children. Report of the IO verifies the documents regarding the illness of the wife.

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Ld. Counsel for applicant Rajender Yadav submits that applicant was earlier was admitted to interim bail on account of death of his mother and illness of his wife and during the said period, he had not misused the liberty.

File reflects that application for interim bail moved by the applicant on the similar ground was dismissed on 01.11.2019. The allegations against the applicant are that on or before 05.07.2015, at Moradabad, UP, the applicant along with co accused in furtherance of their common intention committed the murder of one Virender and got disappeared the body by throwing the headless portion of the dead body within the territorial jurisdiction of PS: Visharat Ganj, Distt: Bareilly UP and throwing the head of the deceased at Aonla Road, Vill: Mau Chand Pur, Bareilly UP with intention to save themselves from the legal consequences. The allegations are most grievous and serious in nature. Number of witnesses are still to be examined. Therefore, no case is made out for grant of bail. Therefore, **the bail application of applicant Rajender Yadav is accordingly dismissed.** Copy dasti.
