This is the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim bail moved on behalf of the applicant/accused Udayveer Singh on the medical grounds of his mother.

Present: Mr. Harvinder Kumar Nar, Ld. Additional PP for the State.
Mr. J.P. Sharma, ld. Counsel for applicant/accused along with applicant/accused in person on interim bail.
SI Virender Kumar on behalf of SHO PS KNK Marg.
Arguments heard.
Verification report/reply to the bail application has already been filed.

1. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused has argued that the present application is seeking grant of interim bail of the applicant on the medical ground of his mother. It is submitted that applicant/accused will not flout any terms and conditions, if so imposed. It is prayed that a lenient view be taken on humanitarian ground.
2. Ld. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the bail application stating that applicant/accused should not be granted bail owing to the gravity of the offence.
3. I have heard the submissions made by the Ld. Addl. PP for the State and Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused.
4. The verification report regarding the medical documents filed by

the applicant/accused is duly verified by the IO, as per the verification report. The applicant/accused was enlarged on interim bail even earlier on the same grounds and there is nothing to suggest that he has flouted any term or condition of the same.

5. Seeing the facts and circumstances and the verification report filed by IO, taking a lenient view on humanitarian ground, the interim bail already granted to the applicant/accused vide orders dated 30.05.2023 stands further extended for a period of 15 days from today. Rest of the conditions shall remain the same.

The accused shall surrender himself before the concerned Jail Authorities after expiry the period of interim bail.

Application is disposed off accordingly.

6. Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused as well as be sent to concerned IO, concerned Jail Superintendent, Ld. Secretary, DLSA (North), through all possible modes, as per rules, by the court staff.
