PARVEEN AND ORS Vs. MD ABJAL AND ORS

17.03.2026

File taken up today on an application moved by applicants Parveen & Shamshad seeking pre-mature encashment of their entire FDR.

Present: Ms. Faria Rana, Ld. Counsel for applicant alongwith applicant.

Report received from SBI, Rohini. Same is taken on record.

SHO concerned, NIA has filed verification report regarding structure of building bearing property No. B-1970, Block-B, Metro Vihar, Phase-II. Holalbi Kalan alongwith photographs.

It is submitted by both the applicants that they require the release of their entire FDR as currently they reside on rented premises and need to construct their own house. It is further submitted that Shamshad is a daily wage laborer and earns about Rs. 12,000/- per month.

Heard on the application. Record perused.

The applicants are seeking pre-mature encashment of their entire FDR on the ground that they are in need of funds in order to construct their own home as Ms. Parveen is a housewife and Mr. Shamshad is a daily wage labourer who earns about Rs. 12,000/- per month out of which Rs. 3,000/- goes as rent for the rented premises where they currently reside. It is therefore prayed that the entire amount be released to them for the aforesaid purpose into their savings account. The applicants have also annexed verification report regarding structure of

building bearing property No. B-1970, Block-B, Metro Vihar, Phase-II. Holalbi Kalan alongwith photographs.

Vide order dated 08.03.2025, Lok Adalat award for a total sum of Rs. 27,50,000/- was passed in favour of petitioners/applicants. It may be noted here that vide aforesaid award, Rs. 17,50,000/- was directed to be given to Ms. Parveen and Rs. 10,00,000/- was directed to be given to the father namely Sh. Shamshad. Thereafter, an amount of Rs. 5,50,000/- was released to Ms. Parveen and Rs. 3,00,000/- were released to Sh. Shamshad and the remaining amount was directed to be kept in their respective FDRs.

Taking into consideration the submissions made and in the facts and circumstances, Manager, SBI Rohini Courts Branch is directed to release the entire remaining sum awarded to both the petitioners namely Parveen and Shamshad vide order dated 08.03.2025 cumulative of interest and other procedural formalities with the bank, on completing necessary formalities, as per rules. Application stands disposed of accordingly.

File be sent back to record room after necessary compliance.
