This (case type) having come before me for hearing today, having heard and considered the record, this court delivered the following :

ORDER

Accused is present. Copies of case documents are furnished to him under Sec. 207 Cr.P.C. He is examined under Sec.251 Cr.P.C., explaining the substance of the accusation levelled against him in vernacular language, for the offence under Sec. 185(a) of MV Act., for which he pleaded guilty. This Court warned the accused and

informed him about the punishment prescribed for the offence committed by him. Even then the Accused admitted his guilt. Hence, this Court feels that the guilt pleaded by the Accused is true and voluntary. Accused is heard with regard to the quantum of sentences to be imposed against him. He prayed the Court to take lenient view as it was first offence. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court is inclined to take little bit lenient view while imposing sentence. IN THE RESULT, Accused is found guilty for the offence punishable under Sec. 185(a) of MV Act., and he is convicted under Section 252 Cr.P.C., for the said offence. Accordingly, Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- for the offence under Sec.185(a) of MV Act., in default of payment of fine, he shall undergo SI for (30) days. Total fine comes to Rs.1,000/-. No case property in this case
