The present case file is hereby assigned to the court of Ld. Special Judge-II, Bilaspur, District Bilaspur, H.P. for disposal in accordance with law forthwith. The parties are directed to appear before the concerned court on 05-03-2026. Case file after doing the needful be sent to the concerned court forthwith.

The accused be produced before the concerned court on the date fixed at 10.00 a.m. sharp through the mode of video conferencing.

The accused is sent back to jail and he be produced before the concerned court through video conferencing.

Matter is listed for prosecution evidence, however, today no PW is present. List the matter for prosecution evidence on 21-02-2026, the date already fixed. Let the prosecution witnesses mentioned in the list of witnesses at sr. nos.14 to 19 be summoned for 03-12-2025. The witnesses be summoned in equal numbers for the date fixed.

Ld. P.P. filed the written arguments and the same is taken on record. Arguments partly heard. Now list the matter for final/remaining arguments on 24-11-2025.

Report of Mediation has been filed. Further time is granted to the Mediator, however, report be called on or before 09-12-2025.

The case is taken up today, as it has been remanded back from the Hon'ble High Court of H.P., whereby the judgment dated 25-09-2024 has been set aside and the matter has been remanded back to proceed from the stage of recording evidence, after the statement of PW-7, which was recorded on 26-07-2023.

Sh. Anil Kumar Sharma, Deputy Chief Legal Aid Defence Counsel is hereby appointed as Advocate in this case, as no Advocate has appeared for both the accused persons and earlier also Sh. Anil Kumar Sharma was counsel for them. Information be sent to Secretary, District Legal Service Authority in this regard forthwith. Be put up for consideration on 05-12-2025.

Notice not received back neither the accused is present, therefore,

the accused be served through bailable warrant in the sum of Rs.2,000/- with one surety each in the like amount returnable by the next date to be served through SHO P.S. Sadar. List the matter on 08-04-2026.

Office report has been made that the release of this amount has been ordered to be kept in abeyance by the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. vide order dated 21-06-2025 till the time the order dated 04-03-2020 is complied with. Hence, the learned counsel for the applicant is directed to file the copy of order dated 04-03-2020 on or before 02-12-2025.

At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner has moved an application for transfer of bail application to the court of Ld. Additional Special Judge, Ghumarwin. It is averred that the challan of the present case has been presented and the same is pending before the court of Ld. Additional Special Judge, Ghumarwin.

Considering the averments made in the application, the same is allowed for the reasons stated therein. The present bail application is hereby transferred to the court of Ld. Additional Special Judge, Ghumarwin. Criminal Ahlmad to do the needful accordingly. After doing the needful, it be sent to the concerned court forthwith.

The respondent could not be served despite many efforts. Correct address of the respondent is not found, therefore, the present petition be disposed off for want of prosecution. However, petitioners are at liberty to file fresh application/petition on the same cause of action, whenever whereabouts of the respondent are known. It stands disposed off. After due completion it be consigned to the record room.

An application seeking personal exemption of accused filed by the learned counsel is considered and allowed for the reasons mentioned therein for today only. Accused be produced on the next date of hearing. Application stands disposed off. It be registered and tagged with the main case file.

Conciliation tried. There are element of settlement between the parties, therefore, case be referred to Secretary, District Legal Service Authority for mediation for the appointment of a mediator. The parties are directed to appear before the mediator at ADR Centre, Bilaspur, H.P. today itself at 12.00 p.m. sharp and report be called on or before 11-05-2026.

Till then the accused is sent back to judicial custody and he be produced before this court physically on the date fixed at 10.00

a.m. sharp.

Summons issued to the complainant not received back either served or unserved. Let the complainant be again served afresh through SHO P.S. Kot Kehloor and report be called for the next date. Be put up on 09-03-2026.

Be tagged.

Heard. Record perused. There are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused persons for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-A and 323 IPC read with Section 34 IPC. Hence, cognizance taken. Let the accused persons be summoned for 13-03-2024.

The copies of challan as were supplied to the accused are stated to be correctly prepared. Perusal of record shows sufficient grounds and prima facie case to frame charge against the accused for the commission of offences punishable under Section 3(1)(r) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 351(2) & 352 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. Accordingly, charge is framed and put to the accused, to which he pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Now list the matter for fixation of date of prosecution evidence on 08-05-2026.

Today one witness, namely, Dr. Sandeep Kalia is present and his statement recorded through video conferencing. Let the scanned copy of his statement be sent to him through e-mail with a request to put his signature over the statement and after putting signature over the statement get the same scanned and be sent to this office through e-mail, whereas, the hard copy over which witness shall put his signature be sent to this court through registered letter.

Costs of ₹ 1,000/- imposed upon the appellant vide order dated 29.10.2025 stands paid and same be deposited in the "District Disaster Relief Fund" bank accounts maintained by the District Legal Services Authority, Bilaspur, H.P. in view of the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. vide letter no.HHC/Accts./Relief Fund/2025-44576 dated 19th December, 2025.

In view of above, Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Bilaspur, H.P. is hereby directed to remit/transfer the said amount/cost to the "Chief Justice Disaster Relief Fund" Bank account no.18330110060070, maintained with UCO Bank, High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla. A copy of this order be also sent to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Bilaspur, H.P. along with amount of costs for necessary action.

Main appeal be registered. Copy supplied. Now list the matter for final arguments on 18-03-2026.

Heard on objections filed by the JD no.1. It is contended by the JD no.1 that he had not plied the said vehicle and possession of the same was never handed over. It is further contended that he had been cheated and dragged to the litigation. It is further contended by the JD no.1 that DH has recovered ₹ 2.5 lacs from him through the recovery agents, but they did not issue the receipt(s). Both the parties have submitted a Compromise Deed dated 24.03.2026, which has been placed on record as Ext.P-1. The compromise has been perused. Statements of both the parties have already been recorded separately, wherein they have categorically stated that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, out of their free will, without any coercion, undue influence, or pressure, and that they shall abide by the terms and conditions of the same.

It is observed that the dispute between the parties is matrimonial in nature, and with the intervention of respectable persons and family members, the parties have amicably resolved their disputes and have agreed to resume cohabitation.

In view of the statements of the parties and the contents of the compromise deed, this Court is satisfied that the compromise is lawful, genuine, and deserves to be accepted. Accordingly, the compromise is accepted and the case is disposed of in terms of the compromise with the following directions, which are as under:

- (a) The parties shall resume cohabitation and live together as husband and wife at the house of the decree holder.

(b) The DH shall pay a sum of ₹5,000/- per month to the JD (Suman Devi) towards maintenance and the said amount shall be deposited in the bank account of the JD on or before the 7th day of every month.

(c) In view of the compromise, the order of attachment of salary of the DH is hereby withdrawn and the concerned authority, i.e., I.P.H. Division, Zakatkhana, Tehsil Shri Naina Devi Ji, District Bilaspur, H.P., is directed to de-attach the salary of the DH (Satpal) forthwith. In case of default in payment of maintenance by the DH, the JD shall be at liberty to move appropriate application, and this Court shall be competent to re-attach the salary of the DH in accordance with law.

(d) The parties shall withdraw all pending litigations, if any, against each other, in accordance with law.

(e) Both parties shall maintain cordial relations and shall not subject each other to any form of harassment, physical or mental.

The compromise deed (Ext.P-1) shall form part of this order. Execution petition stands disposed off accordingly. The file after due completion be consigned to the record room.

This order shall dispose of an application filed by the applicants/petitioners seeking release of the deposited amount alongwith accrued interest. It is averred that the claim petition was decided by this Tribunal on 14-03-2014 and a sum of ₹6,00,000/- along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum was awarded. It is further averred that this Tribunal had awarded the amount of ₹50,000/- on account of no fault liability to the petitioners and the insurance company had deposited the said amount with this Tribunal and the said amount is lying undisbursed to the petitioners. On these grounds, it has been prayed that the application be allowed.

2. The respondent–Insurance Company has raised preliminary objections to the effect that the present application is not maintainable, the petitioners have no locus standi, the petitioners are estopped by their own act and conduct from filing the present application and that the present application is not bonafide and has been filed by concealing material facts. On merits, it is contended that no liability has been fastened upon the respondent/insurance company under Award dated 14.03.2014 and, therefore, the present application is not maintainable. It is further contended that the amount of ₹50,000/- was deposited without admission of liability and subject to final adjudication. On these grounds, it has been prayed that the application be

dismissed.

3. I have heard the learned counsels for the parties and have also gone through the record carefully. It is an admitted position that an amount of ₹50,000/- stands deposited before this Tribunal under no-fault liability (Section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act) and the liability under Section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act is statutory, absolute and independent of the final outcome of the claim petition. Once such amount is deposited, the same is intended for immediate relief to the claimants and cannot be withheld on technical objections. Furthermore, in the execution application under Order 21 Rule 11(2) C.P.C. seeking recovery of ₹50,000/-, this Tribunal had passed the order dated 15-10-2015 vide which this Tribunal had observed in view of **Indra Devi & Ors. Vs. Bagada Ram & Anr. AIR 2010 Supreme Court 2913** that the amount of interim compensation paid by the insurer under Section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act cannot be recovered, as it is no fault liability. In view of order dated 15-10-2015 passed by this Tribunal and law cited, I am of the opinion that the objections filed by the respondent are not sustainable. Accordingly, the objections taken by the respondent are disposed off being rejected.

4. The applicants are the legal representatives of the deceased and are entitled to the amount deposited. It is also not disputed that applicants No.2 and 3 have attained majority because in this regard, the learned counsel for the applicants has placed on record copy of detailed marks certificate, B.Sc. Nursing First Year pertaining to applicant no.2 and copy of matriculation examination certificate-cum detail of marks pertaining to applicant no.3, which further makes it clear that the applicants no.2 and 3 have attained majority. Keeping in view the relationship of the parties and ends of justice, the amount deserves to be apportioned appropriately. Consequently, the present application is hereby allowed and it is ordered that the amount of ₹50,000/- (Rupees

Fifty Thousand only), alongwith accrued interest lying deposited before this Tribunal, be released in favour of the applicants/petitioners in equal shares, as per rules, against proper receipt and identification by depositing the same in their individual saving bank account on furnishing correct particulars. Naib Nazir is directed to ensure compliance as per rules forthwith. The application stands disposed off. The file, after due completion, be consigned to the record room.
