ORDER

1. The present anticipatory bail application has been filed by the petitioner Bhupinder Singh, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 24.5.2023, under sections 323, 452, 506/34 IPC, Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. He further submitted that on the statement of Amarjit Singh, brother of co-accused Parminder Singh, FIR No.127 dated 8.10.2022, under section 323, 324, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC has been registered at Police Station Maqsoodan, Jalandhar against Vijay Dhiman and 20 – 25 other persons including the present complainant. The petitioner is being involved in this case just as a counter-blast to that case. Moreover, co-accused have already been released on anticipatory bail. He further

submitted that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is no more required by the police for the purpose of investigation in this case.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl.Public Prosecutor has submitted that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but keeping in view of the serious nature of allegations, the petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Addl.Public Prosecutor for the State and have also gone through the record of the case. It is not disputed that co-accused have already been released on anticipatory bail. It is the case of the petitioner that the present case has been registered as a counter-blast to the FIR No.127 dated 8.10.2022, under section 323, 324, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Maqsoodan, Jalandhar, which has been registered against the present complainant and others, on the statement of Amarjit Singh, who is brother of co-accused Parminder Singh. The petitioner has already joined the investigation. Thus, keeping in view above, without commenting on the merits of the case, interim order dated 8.6.2023 is made absolute. Anticipatory bail application is disposed of accordingly. File of this bail application be consigned to Record Room.
