ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose off anticipatory bail
application filed by accused/applicant.

2. Counsel for the accused/ applicant submitted that accused
has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any offence.

He further submitted that the challan against remaining accused is already pending and accused was got declared proclaimed offender by the police but no notice or summon was issued to accused but accused was declared proclaimed offender on 28.11.2018 but when accused came to know regarding the case, he filed this application and he is ready to join the investigation. No custodial interrogation is required. So, accused/applicant be released on bail.

3. On the other hand, APP for the State opposed the bail application and requested that he is not entitled for any bail.

4. After hearing the arguments of learned APP for the State and learned counsel for the accused, I have perused the police file.

5. As the FIR was registered against accused alongwith other co-accused under section 420,406,120-B IPC on the statement of Pawan Kumar. Challan against co-accused are already presented and fixed for evidence. Before presenting the challan, police has got declared accused Nar Singh as proclaimed offender on 28.11.2018 and he was shown in column no.2 of the challan. As the main challan was presented and custodial interrogation of accused/applicant is not required. He is ready to join the investigation. Therefore, anticipatory bail application is allowed and applicant/accused is directed to join the investigation within 10 days from the order before IO and cooperate with the same and in the event of his arrest, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer on the conditions:

1. That applicant/accused shall appear before learned Investigating Officer as and when is is called upon.
2. That the applicant/accused shall not leave India without the prior permission of the court.
3. That the applicant/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade from disclosing such facts to the court, during trial.

6. Adjourned to 30.10.2024 for awaiting report from concerned police station as to whether applicant/accused has joined the investigation or not and as to whether he has co-operated with the investigation or not? Trial court record be returned. Copy of order be sent to IO/SHO concerned. However, it is reiterated that observations made herein above shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the main case.
