Sukhwinder Kumar and another vs. State of Punjab

1. The applicants/accused Sukhwinder Kumar son of Pali Ram and Ravi Kumar son of Wassan Lal have sought anticipatory bail in the case arising out of FIR No. 270 dated 09.12.2020, under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Dhariwal.

2. Heard. The applicants/accused have been summoned by the learned trial Court to face trial under Section 420 IPC while exercising the powers under Section 319 Cr.P.C., vide summoning order dated 30.03.2024. Thus, it is made out that the applicants/accused were declared innocent by the police. Further, they are not required for custodial interrogation by the police in connection with the investigation of this case. The disposal of the case will take time. No useful purpose is likely to be served by sending the applicants/accused to the jail at this stage. Under these circumstances, the instant application is disposed off with the directions that in case the applicants/accused cause their appearance before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 10 days, the trial Court/Duty Magistrate shall admit them to bail on furnishing of bail bonds to its satisfaction. However, the Court concerned shall be at liberty to impose any other condition upon the applicants/accused at the time of admitting them to bail. In case the applicants/accused misuse the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order.

The trial court record alongwith copy of this order be returned
to the Court concerned and the instant file be consigned to the record room.
