Perusal of the file shows that time and again, processes have been issued on the address mentioned in the challan to secure presence of accused but his presence could not be secured due to one reason or the other. That being the case, further issuance of processes would be a sheer waste of precious time of the Court and it would also put unnecessary burden on the State exchequer. In these circumstances, instant proceedings are ordered to be stopped under Section 258 of Cr.P.C. (now Section 281 BNSS). The instant proceedings shall be revived on application of either party. File be consigned to the record room, after due compliance with a note not to destroy the same as accused is yet to appear and face trial in the present case.
