

Misc DJ No. 290/2026 in MACP No. 680/17
Rup Rani Vs. Shiv Kumar Bansal & Ors.

Present: Sh. P.K. Poddar, Ld. Counsel for applicants/LRs of deceased petitioner no. 1 & 2 with all the LRs of both the deceased.

This is an application filed on behalf of the applicants seeking direction to the concerned Bank Manager for release of entire compensation amount lying in the bank account of deceased petitioner no. 1 & 2 namely Ram Sukh and Smt. Rup Rani as they have already expired. Copies of death certificates of both the deceased are also annexed with the present application.

Death verification report received as verified.

Heard on the aforesaid application. Record perused.

It is apparent from the death certificates filed on record that petitioner no. 1 Sh. Ram Sukh and petitioner no. 2 Smt. Rup Rani have already expired.

Report from the concerned bank received.

A perusal of the bank report reveals that both the deceased being husband and wife were the nominee in each others bank accounts.

It is submitted by the counsel for applicants that there were five children of deceased petitioner no. 1 & 2 including deceased Ramsanjeevan who is their predeceased son.

At this stage, it is submitted by both daughters of petitioner no. 1 & 2 that they have no objection, if the amount lying in the bank account of their deceased parents may be given to their brothers. Their joint statement in this regard recorded separately today.

In view of the aforesaid and the fact that both the petitioners i.e., petitioner no. 1 & 2 have already expired, concerned

Manager, SBI, Rohini Court Branch is directed to disburse the entire amount alongwith up to date interest in equal proportion to both the sons of petitioner no. 1 & 2 namely Jagjivan and Rahul Kumar and their granddaughter namely Riddhi who was petitioner no. 3 in the present case. He is further directed to release the entire respective share amounts of both the sons of deceased petitioner no. 1 & 2 to them in their respective saving bank accounts, on completing necessary formalities as per rules. He is further directed to keep the entire share amount of petitioner no. 3 Riddhi in FDR for the period till she attains the age of majority. With these directions, present application stands disposed off. Be tagged with main case file. Copy of this order be given dasti.
