Two applications were filed by the DH. One was for arrest of the JD. The other is for breaking open of the locks as well as police aid. Copies of these applications be supplied to the opposite counsel via whatsapp.

Report of the bailiff dated 04.04.2025 perused. It is reported therein that the premises was locked and the JD was found to be unavailable. In these circumstances, the application filed by the DH for breaking open of the locks and police aid is allowed. The bailiff shall be at liberty to break open the locks as well as seek police aid, if the need so arises. The SHO concerned shall be duty bound to provide necessary assistance, as and when sought by the bailiff.

Accordingly, fresh warrants of attachment be issued with respect to movable properties of JD, as per list attached, on filing PF and filing affidavit verifying that there is no stay.

Be put up before Ld. ACJ on 25.08.2025 for appointment of Bailiff and before this court on 14.11.2025 for further proceedings, as per law.

In the meantime, the JD shall be at liberty to file reply to the application filed for the arrest, with advance copy to the opposite party.
