ORDER

Accused called present and filed a memo stating that the case may be advanced from 13.10.2023 to today i.e., on 01.09.2023. Hence, the case advanced to today and examined U/Sec.251 Cr.P.C The substance of accusation levelled against the accused U/Sec.337 IPC and Sec. 181 of MV Act was read over and explained to him in

Telugu. For which, he pleaded guilty. The admission of the accused is found to be made voluntarily. The Accused is found guilty for the offence U/Sec.337 IPC and Sec. 181 of MV Act and he is convicted under sec.252 CrPC and he is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only) for the offence punishable under section 337 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of One (01) month and he is convicted under sec.252 CrPC and he is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) for the offence punishable under section 181 of MV Act. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of One (01) month Total fine amount of Rs.1500/-[Rs. One thousand five hundred only].
