- 1) Perused the complaint, documents placed on record and verification statements of the complainant under section 223 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
- 2) After going through the verification statements and the documents on record, it appears that, the cheque in question was given by the accused to the complainant and on presentation of the said cheque, it was dishonored. Notice was issued to the accused intimating him about the dishonor of the cheque and claiming the cheque amount. Despite the service of notice on the accused, he did not pay the cheque amount.
- 3) It is seen that the statutory period time frame has been observed. As such, there are sufficient reasons to proceed against the accused. Hence, I pass following order -

ORDER

1. Issue process against the accused for the offence punishable under section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
2. Issue sommons to the accused accordingly R/o. 11/07/2025.
