

Balwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER:

This order of mine shall dispose of this bail application, moved by above named accused/ applicant Balwinder Singh, under section 439 of Cr.P.C, pertaining to a criminal case registered against him, vide FIR No. 102 dated 08.04.2017, under section 379-B (1) of IPC, P.S. City, Kapurthala.

2. Notice of this bail application was given to Ld.P.P for the State, who appeared and opposed this bail application. Record of the trial pending in this Court was also summoned.

4. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused has contended that the accused/ applicant is in custody since 12.11.2018 and he has not committed any offence, as such, he is entitled to concession of bail, whereas, Ld. PP for the State has contended that accused/ applicant has committed a heinous crime and he should not be allowed the concession of bail.

5. As per prosecution case, complainant Amita Rani suffered a statement before the police that on 21.03.2017 at about 4.00 p.m, she was going to drop her grandson at his tuition situated in the Mohalla itself. When she reached at some distance from her house on foot, then two young boys came on Hero Honda motorcycle and the pillion rider alighted

from motorcycle and the second went ahead of street and snatched her ear rings from backside and ran away from the spot. Present case was registered against accused/ applicant.

6. In the present case, challan has already been presented in the Court, charge has already been framed. Accused/ applicant is in custody since 12.11.2018. Conclusion of trial would take time. Nothing is to be recovered from him. Keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances of this case, bail application moved by applicant/ accused stands allowed and disposed off. Accused/ applicant Balwinder Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the same amount to the satisfaction of this Court and file be tagged with the main case titled as State Vs. Gurpreet Singh and Anr.
