Record is put up today on receipt of the mediation report dt. 29.06.26 submitted by Ld. Mediator, Smt. Mousumi Banerjee and communicated vide No. 2372/DLSA/South 24 Parganas/2026 dated 01.07.2026 by the Secretary, DLSA, South 24 Parganas. Let the same be kept with the record.

Perused the communication letter as also the mediation report.

From the mediation report submitted by Ld. Mediator, Smt. Mousumi Banerjee, it transpires that a compromise has been arrived between the contesting parties of this case through mediation, as such mediation was successful. It also appears that the terms of settlement in such mediation proceeding are valid and proper and not illegal in the eye of law.

In the light of the aforesaid reasons and in view of the compromise arrived at between the contesting parties, the OP no. 2, ICICI Lombard General Insurance Co. Ltd. is hereby directed to issue an account payee cheque of Rs. 2,40,000/- in the name of the injured/victim, Amiya Krishna Banerjee within 01.08.2026 and deposit the same before this court, failing compliance the award shall carry interest as per present Nationalized Bank rate.

In view of the fact of successful mediation, the instant case is hereby disposed of.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the instant MAC Case no. 237 of 2026 be and the same is hereby disposed of in terms of the mediation report dated 29.06.2026 containing the terms and conditions of settlement.
