File taken up today on an application moved by the accused u/s 439(i) of Cr.PC seeking interim bail for a period of 15 days.

Present : Sh. Ajay Kumar Mishra, learned Chief Prosecutor for the State.

Sh. Jai Subhash Thakur, learned Counsel for the applicant/accused.

Reply of the application under reference has already been received.

Heard.

Learned Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that the grandmother of the applicant/accused was expired on 03.05.2021 and the applicant/accused is required to perform rituals of her late grandmother. It is accordingly prayed that interim bail for a period of 15 days may be granted to the applicant/accused so that the applicant/accused could perform rituals of her late grandmother.

On the other hand, learned Chief Prosecutor for the State has vehemently opposed the present bail application stating that last rite of the grandmother of the application/accused has already been performed, hence, nothing is remained to be performed by the applicant/accused. He further states that even

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otherwise the applicant/accused is the grandson of the deceased not son or daughter of the deceased.

Let verification report in regard to death of grandmother of the applicant/accused be called by the Investigating Officer. Investigating Officer may verify through *online* if he so desires.
