BADAL (MINOR) Vs. HARENDER SINGH AND ANR

File taken up today on an application moved by applicant/petitioner no. 1 Badal Patel S/o Sh. Nandkishore seeking pre-mature encashment of his FDR to the tune of Rs. 5,00,000/-.

Present : Ms. Ritu, Ld. counsel for applicant.

Heard on the application. Record perused.

The applicant is seeking pre-mature encashment of his FDR to the tune of Rs. 5,00,000/- only on the ground that he is in need of funds for medical treatment due to injury condition. Also, he has become financial burden due to the said injury inflicted upon him. Accordingly, he requires release of his FDR. It is therefore prayed that only a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- out of the remaining share amount of applicant/petitioner no. 1 be released to him for aforesaid purpose. The applicant has also annexed his medical documents to support his claim.

Vide order dated 13.09.2025, Lok Adalat award for a total sum of Rs. 20,00,000/- was passed in favour of petitioner. It may be noted here that vide aforesaid award, Rs. 15,00,000/- was directed to be kept in FDRs i.e. one FDR of Rs. 10,00,000/- and other of Rs. 5,00,000/-.

Taking into consideration the submissions made and in the facts and circumstances, Manager, SBI Rohini Courts Branch is directed to release only a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- to the applicant/petitioner no. 1 Badal out of his remaining compensation amount lying with the bank, on completing necessary formalities, as per rules. Application stands disposed of

accordingly.
